Unit 7 - Physical Geography of Asia

Asian Travel Journal Project



For the following project you will be required to pretend you are traveling in an Asian country and create a journal of your travels and adventures in that country. Imagine that you have gone on a trip to that country in Asia! As you travel there, you will record your observations, experiences, and what you see while you are there.

The following 6 objectives **MUST** be included in your travel journal:

1. Important rivers, mountains, deserts, and other landforms you saw in that country.
2. Climate patterns of the country.
3. Natural resources and economic activity of that country.
4. The kinds of activities and fun things you saw and did while you were visiting that country (at least 3).
5. Difficulties that you encountered while traveling there.
6. Important sights or places that were incredible and that any traveler will not want to miss (at least 1)!

Dedicate one page to each objective above. **Make sure you write as if you are really traveling there!** Include at least one picture (from magazines, the Internet or your own drawings) for each page. Each *complete page that covers each objective above* earns you 10 points. You will also be required to include a cover page that has: a title, a picture, your name, the name of the class, and the date on it. The cover page is worth 5 points. When you are finished, you should have 7 pages altogether (6 objectives plus the cover page).

Be creative and learn: use construction paper for your book, bind it with ribbon or plastic, and laminate the cover and a separate back page. The possibilities are endless! Use lots of imagination and don't forget to write as if you are truly traveling in that country and recording facts and observations for your journal!

Make sure you read and follow all directions. This project is worth 65 points.
