



Creative Writing Morphing Project

For the teacher: Go through that big stack of magazines you have people save for you, and cut out pictures with no particular theme in mind. Take your big stack of pictures to school and place them in a large manila envelope. Go around the room and ask students to reach into the envelope and pull out ten random pictures.

For students: Students are to take their ten pictures and brainstorm ideas for a story that incorporates ALL the pictures. The story must link the pictures together. This can be challenging but it will definitely flex your creative muscle!

If you are stumped, as a last resort, write something about each picture separately, **and then morph them together.**

Finally, collage everything onto a poster board (pictures and story) to creatively and attractively display your project.

Story & Project Requirements:

- About 500 words; 12 size font & Ariel or Times New Roman only
- Use only the front side of each page since you will be pasting your story to a poster board
- If you choose to handwrite, please write neatly & double space
- Practice writing descriptively & use a thesaurus to practice expanding your vocabulary
- A hook; an introductory sentence and paragraph that grabs the reader's attention
- Proofread several times before turning the story in
- Use imagination, make your story exciting!
- Paste all of your pictures neatly onto a poster board with your story in the middle.
